<p>10 November 2018</p>	<p>Betws-y-Coed</p>	<p>Betws y Coed Trail Challenge</p> <p>Betws-y-coed Trail Challenge takes competitors on what must be one of the toughest and most beautiful trail running courses in the UK - in fact most of our route was also used for the 2015 World Mountain Running Championships. From the start line behind St Mary's Church in Betws-y-coed both 10k and 5k routes climb up into the Gwydyr Forest where they split to allow the longer route to do a lap of Llyn Elsi, before joining back up to finish at the Waterloo Hotel. The 10k & 5k races start at 1:00pm from the centre of Betws-y-Coed. 18 Nov 2018	Conwy	<p>Conwy Half Marathon</p> <p>Voted in the top 5 most scenic Half Marathons in the UK by Readers of Runners World, this GREAT Half Marathon is now in its 10th year and is "already being regarded as a classic". The start and finish are on the quayside in front of the 700+ year old Conwy Castle. 2017 saw over 3,000 runners take part and many PB's were achieved. The route runs along the road adjacent to the Conwy River as it proceeds towards Deganwy beach and the West Shore Llandudno, from there it goes along church Walks towards Llandudno Pier, then around the Great Orme taking in views of the Isle of Anglesey, Puffin Island and the surrounding North Wales coastline, then back to Conwy and the finish line.
